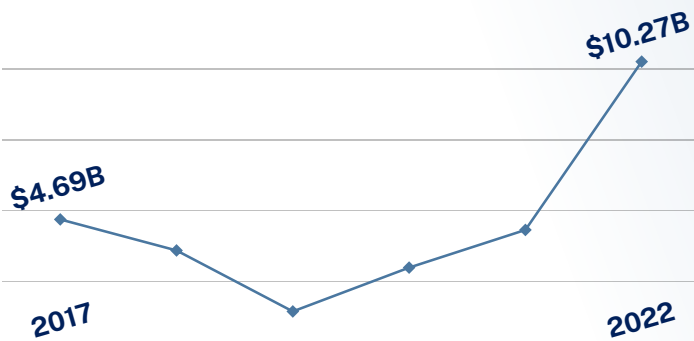

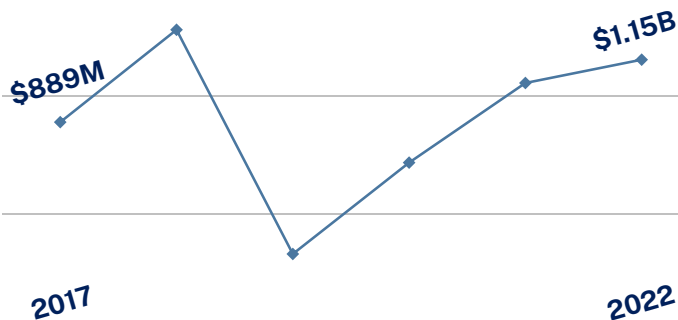

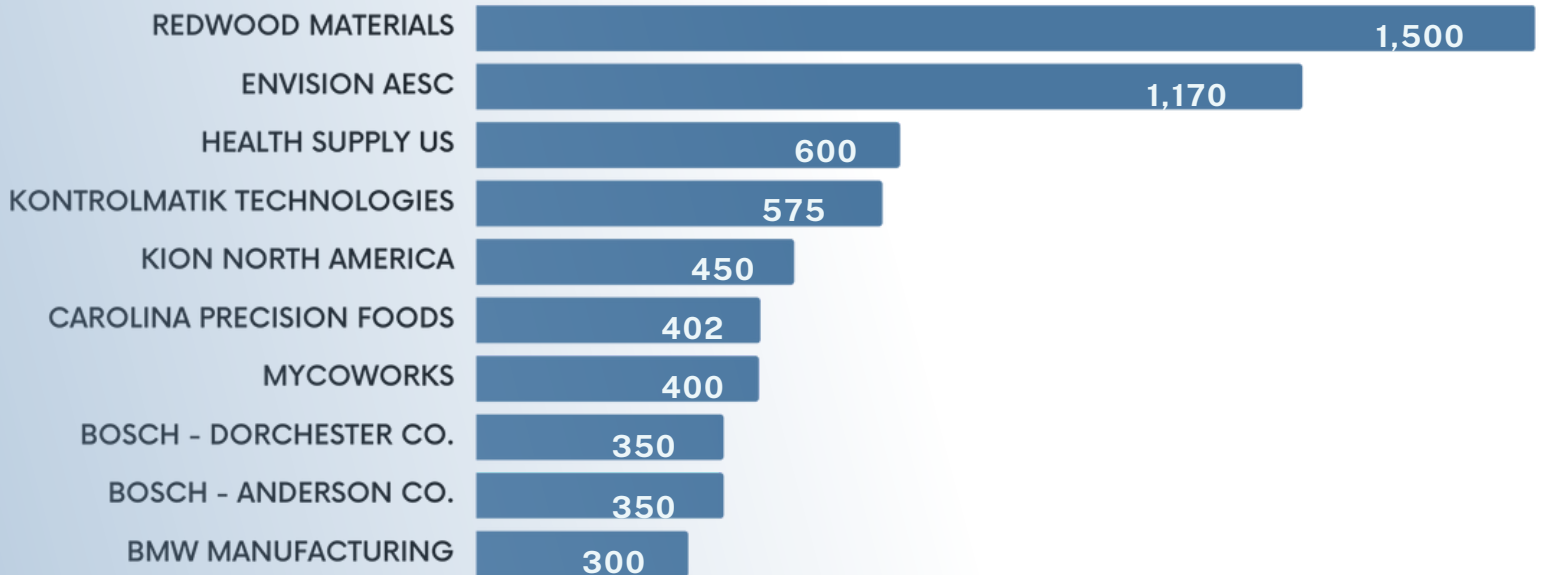

INVESTMENTS ANNOUNCED BY COUNTRY OF ORIGIN

Domestic and international companies alike are finding success in South Carolina. Domestic-based companies made up the majority of investments announced in the state, **accounting for 60.1% of all incoming capital.**

Overall, foreign direct investment in 2022 saw a 371% increase over 2021.

Turkish investments surged in 2022 as compared to previous years, while familiar international partners round out the 2022 list of top sources of announced investments.
